General information

Numerous advances in Science and Technology, in the context of an increasingly globalized world, are assuming greater interaction between members of different cultures and societies. Therefore, Translation is configured as a common and necessary discipline, essential for communication in every knowledge area.

In this context, we organise the **IV International Congress on Science and Translation: "Interdisciplinary bridges and dissemination of scientific knowledge"**, where Translation has an essential role in the exchange of ideas and scientific advances. The Congress aims to be a meeting point as well as a discussion forum in which highlighting the relationship -

sometimes imperceptible, but in any case necessary- between Science and Translation. The Congress will be organized around four main sections:

- Panel 1 Translation in specialized contexts
- Panel 2 Interpreting in specialized contexts
- Panel 3 Translation and Interpreting Teaching Methods
- Panel 4 Languages for Specific Purposes
- Panel 5 New research and professional perspectives

1. Contributions

Contributions -not exceeding 20 minutes- about any of the four previous subjects will be accepted. They may be written in English, French, German, Italian or Spanish.

After the Congress, the authors of the accepted papers will be invited to submit their papers to be evaluated by the Scientific Committee. Papers which pass this evaluation will be published in a monograph of an important editorial.

2. Submission of papers

Those scholars interested in participating as speakers at the Congress must submit an abstract in Spanish as well as in English (not more than 10 lines, minimum 5 keywords and the title of the contribution in both languages) to the email <u>cienciatraduccion@uco.es</u> before 31st January 2020.

Acceptance will be communicated by the Organising Committee before 17th February. Once communication is accepted, speakers must proceed to the payment of the registration fees into the bank account which shall be indicated in a later notice.
